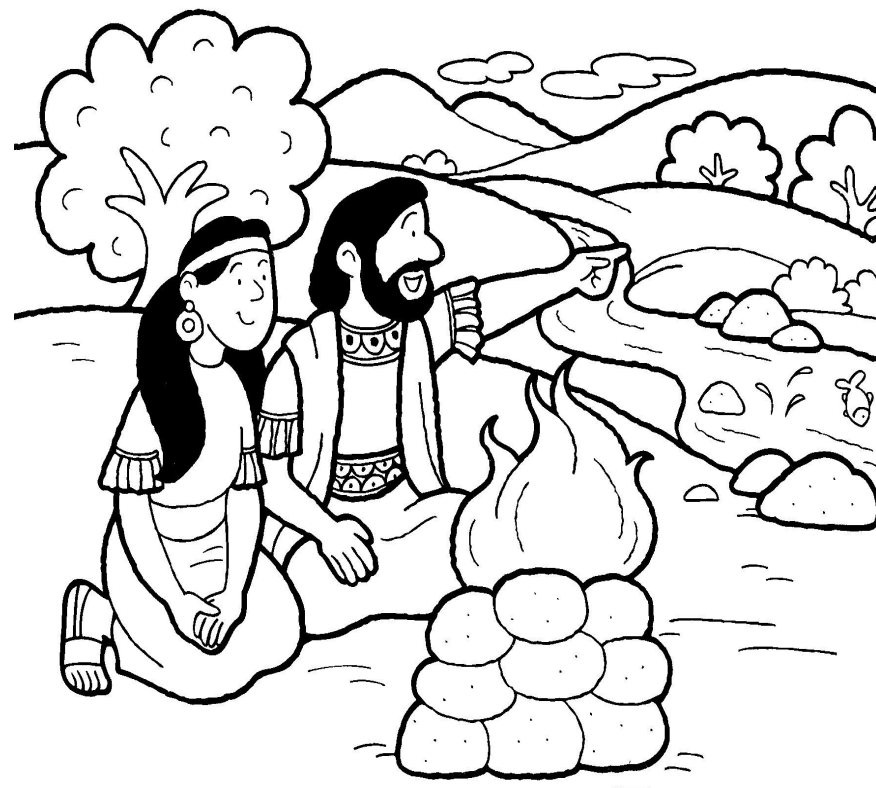

Romans 4:1-5 and Genesis 12:1-4a



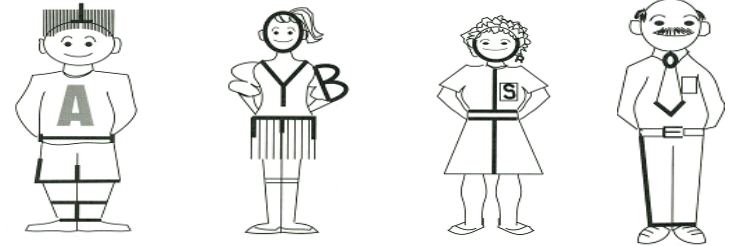
